Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.

4. Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one bidder or bidders having business relationship. Under no circumstances will father and his son(s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e. when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitor. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection. Applicant/bidder must provide non-refundable demand draft of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) with their application/downloaded tenders as the cost of tender forms/documents in favour of Principal, Deshbandhu College, payable at New Delhi, issued by any Nationalized/Scheduled Bank having validity for three months.
